The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 18 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 19 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the 20 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows: 2.1 Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the 22 initiative, and eight per centum percent (8%) of the legal voters of 23 every congressional district of this state shall have the right to 24 propose any legislative measure, and fifteen per centum percent

1	(15%) of the legal voters of every congressional district of this
2	state shall have the right to propose amendments to the Constitution
3	by petition, and every such petition shall include the full text of
4	the measure so proposed. The second power is the referendum, and it
5	may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for the immediate
6	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety), either by
7	petition signed by five per centum <u>percent (5%)</u> of the legal voters
8	of every congressional district of this state or by the Legislature
9	as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per centum of legal
10	voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the total number of
11	votes cast at the last general election for the Office of Governor.
