14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
19	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 30A to Article V thereof, to read
20	as follows:
21	Section 30A. A. A measure which appropriates money to any
22	state governmental entity within the executive branch of state
23	government, including appropriations for support of the common
24	schools of the state, shall first be reviewed by a subcommittee of

- the full committee before the full committee votes on the measure in order to make a final report of the measure for consideration by either chamber of the Legislature.
  - B. If a subcommittee does not approve a measure as required by the provisions of this section, neither that measure nor any measure having substantially the same provisions as that measure shall be reported from the full committee to either chamber of the Legislature.
  - SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in the following form:

THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:

This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It would add a new Section 30A to Article V. Before a measure which appropriates money could be reported from a full committee, the measure would first have to be approved by a subcommittee. If a measure appropriating money did not receive approval by a subcommittee, then that measure or a measure having substantially the same effect as that measure could not be reported by the full committee to either chamber of the Legislature. This measure would apply to appropriations to state government entities in the executive branch and it would
