7	AS INTRODUCED
8	A Joint Resolution calling for a convention to propose a free and fair elections amendment pursuant
9	to the provisions of Article V of the United States Constitution; and directing distribution.

12	
13	WHEREAS, the framers of the Constitution of the United States of
14	America intended that the Congress of the United States of America
15	should be "dependent on the people alone" (James Madison, Federalist
16	52); and
17	WHEREAS, that dependency has evolved from a dependency on the
18	people alone to a dependency on powerful special interests, through
19	campaigns or third-party groups, that has created a fundamental
20	imbalance in our representative democracy; and
21	WHEREAS, Americans across the political spectrum agree that
22	elections in the United States of America should be free from the
23	disproportional influence of special interests and fair enough that
24	any citizen can be elected into office; and

WHEREAS, Article V of the United States Constitution requires
Congress to call a convention for proposing amendments to the
federal Constitution on the application of two-thirds (2/3) of the
legislatures of the several states; and

5 WHEREAS, the Oklahoma Legislature perceives the need for an amendments convention in order to restore balance and integrity to 6 7 our elections by proposing an amendment to the federal Constitution 8 that will permanently protect free and fair elections in America by 9 addressing, inter alia, issues raised by the decisions of the United 10 States Supreme Court in Citizens United v. Federal Election 11 Commission (2010) 130 S.Ct. 876 and related cases and events, and 12 desires that said convention should be so limited; and

13 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma desires that the delegates to 14 said convention shall be comprised equally of individuals currently 15 elected to state and local office, or be selected by election, in 16 each Congressional district for the purpose of serving as delegates, 17 though all individuals elected or appointed to federal office, now 18 or in the past, be prohibited from serving as delegates to the 19 convention, and intends to retain the ability to restrict or expand 20 the power of its delegates within the limits expressed herein; and 21 WHEREAS, the State of Oklahoma intends that this be a continuing 22 application considered together with applications calling for a 23 convention passed in the 2013-2014 Vermont Legislature as R454, the 24 2013-2014 California Legislature as Resolution Chapter 77, the 98th

Illinois General Assembly as SJR 42, the 2014-2015 New Jersey
Legislature as SCR 132, the 2015-2016 Rhode Island Legislature as HR
7670 and SR 2589, and all other passed, pending and future
applications until such time as two-thirds (2/3) of the several
states have applied for a convention for a similar purpose and said
convention is convened by Congress.

7 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 8 AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 9 SECTION 1. That the people of the State of Oklahoma speaking 10 through its Legislature, and pursuant to Article V of the United 11 States Constitution, hereby apply to the United States Congress to 12 call a convention for the exclusive purpose of proposing an 13 amendment to the Constitution of the United States of America that 14 will restore free and fair elections as described herein, as soon as 15 two-thirds (2/3) of the several states have applied for a convention 16 for a similar purpose; and

17 SECTION 2. That the Chief Clerk of the Oklahoma House of 18 Representatives transmit copies of this resolution to the President 19 of the United States, the Vice President of the United States in his 20 capacity as presiding officer of the United States Senate, the 21 Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the Minority 22 Leader of the United States House of Representatives, the President 23 Pro Tempore of the United States Senate, to each Senator and 24 Representative from Oklahoma in the Congress of the United States
