14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 58TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 8C of Article X of the
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 8C. A. Despite any provision to the contrary,
21	beginning January 1, <del>2005</del> 2023, the fair cash value, as determined
22	by law, on each homestead of an individual head of household whose
23	gross household income from all sources for the preceding calendar
24	year did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this

1 section, and which individual head of household who is sixty-five 2 (65) years of age or older  $\overline{r}$  shall not exceed the fair cash value placed upon the property during the first year in which the 3 individual head of household was sixty-five (65) years of age or 4 5 older and had gross household income from all sources which did not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of this section. 6 7 Subject to the limitations of this section, the fair cash value 8 shall not exceed such amount as long as the individual head of 9 household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older owns and 10 occupies the property and as long as the gross household income from 11 all sources does not exceed an amount as provided in subsection B of 12 this section. If any improvements are made to the property, the 13 fair cash value of the improvements shall be assessed in accordance 14 with law by the county assessor and added to the assessed value of 15 the property. Once the fair cash value of the improvements has been 16 added to the fair cash value of the property, the total fair cash 17 value shall not exceed the revised valuation of the property so long 18 as the individual head of household who is sixty-five (65) years of 19 age or older owns and occupies the property and so long as the gross 20 household income from all sources does not exceed an amount as 21 provided in subsection B of this section. For any individual head 22 of household who is sixty-five (65) years of age or older prior to 23 January 1, 1997, and has gross household income from all sources of Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) or less in calendar year 24

1996, the fair cash value of the real property shall be the fair 1 cash value placed upon the property on January 1, 1997. If the 2 individual head of household ceases to own and occupy the property 3 4 or if the gross household income from all sources exceeds an amount 5 as provided in subsection B of this section, the fair cash value of the property shall be determined as if the provisions of Section 8 6 7 of Article X of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma or any other provisions relating to a limitation on the fair cash value of 8 9 locally assessed real property had been in effect during the time 10 the property was valued pursuant to the provisions of this section. 11 B. The income threshold for the gross household income from all sources for an individual head of household under this section shall 12 13 not exceed the amount determined by the United States Department of 14 Housing and Urban Development to be the estimated median income for 15 the preceding year for the county or metropolitan statistical area 16 which includes such county. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall 17 provide such information to each county assessor each year as soon 18 as such information becomes available.

1 This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends 2 Section 8C of Article 10. This section limits the fair cash value of a homestead for individual head of households who are 3 4 sixty-five (65) years of age or older to not exceed the fair 5 cash value placed upon the property during the first year in which the individual head of household was sixty-five (65) years 6 7 of age or older. Currently, this section only applies if the individual head of household meets the age requirement and an 8 9 income limit determined by the United States Department of 10 Housing and Urban Development to be the estimated median income 11 for the preceding year for the county or metropolitan 12 statistical area which includes such county. This measure would 13 eliminate the required income limit. If this measure passes, 14 this section will apply if the individual head of household is 15 sixty-five (65) years of age or older. 16 SHALL THE PROPOSAL BE APPROVED?
