The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 17 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 18 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the 19 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows: 20 Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the 21 initiative, and eight per centum twenty percent (20%) of the legal 22 voters of each congressional district of this state shall have the 23 right to propose any legislative measure, and fifteen per centum 24 twenty percent (20%) of the legal voters of each congressional

Τ	district of this state shall have the right to propose amendments to
2	the Constitution by petition, and every such petition shall include
3	the full text of the measure so proposed. The second power is the
4	referendum, and it may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for
5	the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety),
6	either by petition signed by five per centum <u>percent (5%)</u> of the
7	legal voters or by the Legislature as other bills are enacted. The
8	ratio and per centum <u>percent</u> of legal voters hereinbefore stated
9	shall be based upon the total number of votes cast at the last
10	general election for the Office of Governor.

12	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in

17	This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends the
18	section pertaining to initiative and referendum petitions. The

20	propose certain petitions from statewide to each congressional
21	district of this state.
