7	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
8	to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 23 of
9	Article V of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; allowing a member of the Legislature to be
10	employed as a certified teacher by a public school district in this state while serving or upon
11	completion of term in office; updating gender-neutral language; providing ballot title; and directing
12	filing.

16	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
17	2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
18	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
19	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
20	the following proposed amendment to Section 23 of Article V of the
21	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
22	Section 23. No A. Except as provided in subsection B of this
23	section, no member of the Legislature shall, during the term for
24	which he or she was elected, be appointed or elected to any office

1 or commission in the State state, which shall have been created, or 2 the emoluments of which shall have been increased, during his or her 3 term of office, nor shall any member receive any appointment from 4 the Governor, the Governor and Senate, or from the Legislature, 5 during the term for which he or she shall have been elected, nor 6 shall any member, during the term for which he or she shall have 7 been elected, or within two (2) years thereafter, be interested, 8 directly or indirectly, in any contract with the State state, or any 9 county or other subdivision thereof, authorized by law passed during 10 the term for which he or she shall have been elected. 11 B. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not 12 prohibit a member of the Legislature from being employed as a 13 certified teacher by a public school district in this state while 14 serving or upon completing the term for which he or she was elected. 15 SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional 16 amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in 17 the following form: 18 BALLOT TITLE 19 Legislative Referendum No. State Question No. 20 THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS: 21 This measure amends Section 23 of Article 5 of the Oklahoma 22 Constitution. It allows a member of the Legislature to be 23 employed as a certified teacher by a public school district in 24 this state after he or she completes his or her term in office. \_ \_
