1 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 2 2nd Session of the 55th Legislature (2016) 3 HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION 1053 By: Derby 4 5 6 7 AS INTRODUCED A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State 8 to refer to the people for their approval or 9 rejection proposed amendments to Sections 2, 3 and 4 of Article XIII-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma and Section 4 of Article XIII-B of the 10 Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; eliminating 11 the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education; transferring powers of the State Regents to 12 individual boards of regents or governing boards; changing how appropriations are made to higher 1.3 education institutions; providing for allocation of funds to the higher education institutions; changing 14 how private higher education institutions will coordinate with the State System of Higher Education; 15 changing how funds are appropriated to the Board of Regents of Oklahoma Colleges for certain expenses; 16 providing ballot title; and directing filing. 17 18 19 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 20 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE: 21 SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for 22 their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, 23 the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article XIII-A of 24 the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 2. There is hereby established the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education, consisting of nine (9) members, whose qualifications may be prescribed by law. The Board shall consist of nine (9) members appointed by the Governor, confirmed by the Senate, and who shall be removable only for cause, as provided by law for the removal of officers not subject to impeachment. Upon the taking effect of this Article, the Governor shall appoint the said Regents for terms of office as follows: one for a term of one year, one for a term of two years, one for a term of three years, one for a term of four years, one for a term of five years, one for a term of six years, one for a term of seven years, one for a term of eight years, and one for a term of nine years. Any appointment to fill a vacancy shall be for the balance of the term only. Except as above designated, the term of office of said Regents shall be nine years or until their successors are appointed and qualified. The Regents shall constitute a co-ordinating board of control for all State institutions The board of regents designated by the

- 5. Recommend to the Legislature proposed fees for all of such institutions each institution, and any such fees shall be effective only within the limits prescribed by the Legislature.
- SECTION 2. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article XIII-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 3. The appropriations made by the Legislature for all such institutions shall be made in consolidated form without reference to any particular each board of regents designated by the Oklahoma Constitution or by law as the board of regents or governing board of each institution of higher education described in Section 1 of this Article and the Board of Regents herein created. Each board of regents or governing board shall allocate to each institution for which the board has supervision, management and control according to its needs and functions.

SECTION 3. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 4 of Article XIII-A of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 4. Private, denominational, and other institutions of higher learning may become co-ordinated coordinated with the The Oklahoma State System of Higher Education under regulations set forth by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education as provided for by the Legislature.

SECTION 4. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law, the following proposed amendment to Section 4 of Article XIII-B of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:

Section 4. The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education are hereby Board of Regents of Oklahoma Colleges is authorized to allocate from the funds allocated for the support of its educational institutions named in this Act, appropriated by the Legislature funds sufficient for the payment:

- 1. Payment of the per diem and expenses of the members of the Board of Regents of Oklahoma Colleges, the salaries;
- 2. Salaries and expenses of the clerical help of said employees of the Board; office and
- 3. Office expense, and other expenses necessary for the proper performance of the duties of $\frac{1}{1}$ the Board.
