16	2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:										
L 7	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for										
L8	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,										
L 9	the following proposed amendment to Section 3 of Article V of the										
20	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:										
21	Section 3. A. Referendum petitions shall be filed with the										
22	Secretary of State not more than ninety (90) days after the final										
23	adjournment of the session of the Legislature which passed the bill										

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on which the referendum is demanded. The veto power of the Governor

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shall not extend to measures voted on by the people. All elections on measures referred to the people of the state shall be had at the next election held throughout the state, except when the Legislature or the Governor shall order a special election for the express purpose of making such reference. Any measure referred Except as provided by subsection D of this section, any question submitted to the people by the initiative petition or referendum of a proposal passed by the Legislature for approval or disapproval by the people shall take effect and be in force when it shall have been approved by a majority of the votes cast thereon and not otherwise.

- $\underline{\mathtt{B.}}$ The style of all bills shall be: "Be it Enacted By the People of the State of Oklahoma."
- <u>C.</u> Petitions and orders for the initiative and for the referendum shall be filed with the Secretary of State and addressed to the Governor of the state, who shall submit the same to the people. The Legislature shall make suitable provisions for carrying into effect the provisions of this article.
- D. If an initiative petition to modify the provisions of subsection A of this section for majority approval of amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution or if the provisions of a measure referred by the Legislature to modify the provisions of subsection A of this section for majority approval of amendments to the Oklahoma Constitution contains a proposal for any supermajority approval of such questions, such proposal, whether in the form of an initiative

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petition or in the form of a measure referred by the Legislature,									
shall be required to receive the same supermajority approval at the									
election at which such proposal is being voted upon as the									
supermajority approval requirement proposal contained in such									
petition or contained in such measure.
