8	A Joint Resolution directing the Secretary of State
9	to refer to the people for their approval or rejection a proposed amendment to Section 2 of
10	Article V of the Constitution of the State of Oklahoma; changing percentage of legal voters
11	required for certain petitions; providing ballot title; and directing filing.

14	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE
15	2ND SESSION OF THE 59TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
16	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
17	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
18	the following proposed amendment to Section 2 of Article V of the
19	Constitution of the State of Oklahoma to read as follows:
20	Section 2. The first power reserved by the people is the
21	initiative, and eight per centum <u>percent (8%)</u> of the legal voters <u>of</u>
22	each congressional district of this state shall have the right to
23	propose any legislative measure, and fifteen per centum <u>percent</u>

(15%) of the legal voters of each congressional district of this

1	$\overline{ ext{state}}$ shall have the right to propose amendments to the Constitution
2	by petition, and every such petition shall include the full text of
3	the measure so proposed. The second power is the referendum, and it
4	may be ordered (except as to laws necessary for the immediate
5	preservation of the public peace, health, or safety), either by
6	petition signed by five per centum <u>percent (5%)</u> of the legal voters
7	of each congressional district of this state or by the Legislature
8	as other bills are enacted. The ratio and per centum <u>percent</u> of
9	legal voters hereinbefore stated shall be based upon the total
10	number of votes cast at the last general election for the Office of
11	Governor.
12	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
13	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in
14	the following form:

16	Legislative Referendum No State Question No
17	THE GIST OF THE PROPOSITION IS AS FOLLOWS:
18	This measure amends the Oklahoma Constitution. It amends a
19	section pertaining to initiative and referendum petitions. The
20	amendment changes the percentage of legal voters necessary to
21	propose certain petitions from statewide to each congressional
22	district of this state.
