13	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE

15	SECTION 1. The Secretary of State shall refer to the people for
16	their approval or rejection, as and in the manner provided by law,
17	the following proposed amendment to the Constitution of the State of
18	Oklahoma by adding a new Section 1A to Article VII thereof, to read
19	as follows:
20	This amendment shall be known and may be cited as the "Judicial
21	Reform Amendment".
22	SECTION 2. The Ballot Title for the proposed Constitutional
23	amendment as set forth in SECTION 1 of this resolution shall be in

13	Attorney General.
