submitted to the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the
President Pro Tempore of the Senate the adopted Oklahoma Academic

Standards for English Language Arts and the adopted Oklahoma

Academic Standards for Mathematics.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES AND THE SENATE OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

SECTION 1. A. The Oklahoma Academic Standards for English

Language Arts and the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics

adopted by the State Board of Education and submitted to the Speaker

of the House of Representatives and the President Pro Tempore of the

Senate on February 1, 2016, are hereby approved in whole with

instructions as set forth in Section 2 of this resolution.

SECTION 2. Prior to the State Board of Education fully implementing the Oklahoma Academic Standards for English Language Arts and the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics as approved in Section 1 of this resolution, the Board shall take the following action which shall be completed no later than the beginning of the 2017-2018 school year:

1. Review and compile a list of clarifications, revisions, improvements and additions suggested in the "Oklahoma Academic Standards/Common Core State Standards Comparison Analysis Reports" prepared by the South Central Comprehensive Center at the University of Oklahoma and submitted to the Oklahoma State Department of Education and State Superintendent of Public Instruction Joy Hofmeister on January 25, 2016, and any other clarifications, revisions, improvements and additions suggested by individuals and

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- groups previously identified by the State Department of Education as
 the "Outside Reviewers of the Drafts of the Oklahoma Academic

 Standards for English Language Arts" and the "Outside Reviewers of
 the Drafts of the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics";
 - 2. Submit the compiled list of clarifications, revisions, improvements and additions as described in paragraph 1 of this section to the Outside Reviewers as described in paragraph 1 of this section which shall make comments regarding each clarification, revision, improvement and addition;
 - 3. Revise the Oklahoma Academic Standards for English Language
 Arts and the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics by making
 those clarifications, revisions, improvements and additions which
 are deemed necessary by the Board or for which consensus was reached
 by the Outside Reviewers;
 - 4. Send by electronic mail or otherwise a report outlining the revisions made to the Oklahoma Academic Standards for English

 Language Arts and the Oklahoma Academic Standards for Mathematics in accordance with paragraph 3 of this section or an explanation of why revisions were not made to all members of the Legislature;
 - 5. Upon sending the report as required pursuant to paragraph 4 of this section, the Board shall implement the revised standards and submit a copy of the revised standards to the Secretary of State as provided for in subsection E of Section 11-103.6a-1 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

- 6. The State Board of Education shall have the authority to set any deadline to facilitate taking any of the steps required pursuant to paragraphs 1 through 5 of this section and to immediately take any action which must take place prior to implementation of the standards in the classroom as the Board may deem necessary.
- SECTION 3. AMENDATORY Section 4, Chapter 430, O.S.L.

 7 2014 (70 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 11-103.6a-1), is amended to read

 8 as follows:
 - Section 11-103.6a-1 A. All subject matter standards and revisions to the standards adopted by the State Board of Education pursuant to Section 11-103.6a of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes shall be subject to legislative review as set forth in this section. The standards shall not be implemented by the State Board of Education until the legislative review process is completed as provided for in this section.
 - B. Upon adoption of any subject matter standards, the State Board of Education shall submit the adopted standards to the Speaker of the House of Representatives or a designee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate or a designee prior to the last thirty (30) days of the legislative session.
 - C. By adoption of a joint resolution, the Legislature shall approve the standards in whole or in part, disapprove the standards in whole or in part, amend the standards in whole or in part, approve the standards in whole or in part with instructions to the

1 State Board of Education or disapprove the standards in whole or in part with instructions to the State Board of Education, provided 3 that such joint resolution becomes law in accordance with Section 11 of Article VI of the Oklahoma Constitution. If the joint resolution 5 is vetoed by the Governor in accordance with Section 11 of Article 6 VI of the Oklahoma Constitution and the veto has not been 7 overridden, the standards shall be deemed approved. Legislature fails to adopt a joint resolution within thirty (30) legislative days following submission of the standards, the 10 standards shall be deemed approved.

- D. If the subject matter standards are disapproved in whole or are disapproved in whole with instructions as provided for in this section, the State Board of Education may adopt new standards and submit the new standards for legislative review pursuant to this section. The State Board of Education shall continue to implement current standards in place until the new standards have been reviewed by the Legislature and approved as provided for in this section. If the subject matter standards are amended in whole or in part, approved in whole or in part with instructions or are disapproved in part with instructions, the State Board of Education may revise the standards in accordance with the legislative changes or instructions and implement the standards or revised standards.
- E. Upon final approval of the standards, the standards shall be considered final agency rules. The Board shall submit a copy of the

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- standards to the Secretary of State, who shall include the standards
 in the publication known as the "Oklahoma Administrative Code" in
 the same manner as agency rules are published in the "Code" as
 provided for in the Administrative Procedures Act. All standards
 approved and published as provided for in this subsection shall have
 the same force and effect of law as agency rules promulgated
 pursuant to the Administrative Procedures Act.
 - F. Unless otherwise provided by specific vote of the Legislature, joint resolutions introduced for purposes of approving, disapproving, amending or disapproving with instructions any subject matter standards shall not be subject to regular legislative cutoff dates, shall be limited to such provisions as may be necessary for approving, disapproving, amending or disapproving with instructions any subject matter standards and any such other direction or mandate regarding the standards deemed necessary by the Legislature. The joint resolution shall contain no other provisions.
 - SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to distribute copies of this resolution to the Governor and the editor of "The Oklahoma Register".
 - SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this resolution shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
