16	Capitol, to make a public statement respecting the sanctity of human
17	life and the worth of every unborn individual, and to speak with
18	their elected officials; and
19	WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
20	greatly appreciate the heartfelt involvement of these committed
21	Oklahoma citizens, both young and old, male and female.
