16	the most cases of traumatic brain injuries; and
17	WHEREAS, in 2004-2007, a total of 17,890 traumatic brain
18	injuries occurred among Oklahoma residents that were fatal or
19	serious enough to require hospitalization; and
20	WHEREAS, in 2010, 4,221 Oklahomans sustained a traumatic brain
21	injury; and
22	WHEREAS, the direct medical cost and indirect medical costs of
23	traumatic brain injury, such as lost productivity, totaled an
24	estimated \$60 billion dollars in the United States in 2000; and

WHEREAS, suicide is the highest cause of death from a traumatic
 brain injury; and

3 WHEREAS, the risk of traumatic brain injury is the highest among 4 adolescents, young adults and those older than 75; and 5 WHEREAS, TBI Raiders is an organization whose mission is to help 6 students and young adults who have sustained a traumatic brain 7 injury succeed in both school and in their lives; and WHEREAS, TBI Raiders' purpose is to teach job and leadership 8 9 skills and provide students with and without disabilities the 10 opportunity to not only work together, but to also learn from one 11 another while improving their schools and communities; and 12 WHEREAS, TBI Raiders' goal is to increase awareness about

13 traumatic brain injury and provide those living with the disability 14 with more opportunities and to help them see they are capable of so 15 much more.
