## 1 HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES - FLOOR VERSION 2 STATE OF OKLAHOMA 3 1st Session of the 55th Legislature (2015) 4 HOUSE By: Thomsen RESOLUTION 1015 5 6 7 8 AS INTRODUCED A Resolution proclaiming April 2, 2015, as FCA Day in 9 Oklahoma; commending certain individuals; and 10 directing distribution. 11 12 1.3 WHEREAS, in 1947 the idea of athletes using their influence to 14 endorse Jesus Christ began in Stillwater, Oklahoma, in the heart of 15 Don McClanen as a young student manager for legendary Oklahoma A&M 16 basketball coach, Hank Iba; and 17 WHEREAS, a few years later while Mr. McClanen was head 18 basketball coach at Eastern Oklahoma Junior College in Wilburton, 19 Oklahoma, the idea turned into a vision "to see the world impacted 20 for Jesus Christ through the influence of coaches and athletes"; and 21 WHEREAS, in 1954 his vision was transformed into an official 22 Oklahoma not-for-profit corporation in Norman, Oklahoma, named the 23 Fellowship of Christian Athletes (FCA) with the sole mission "to 24 present to coaches and athletes, and all whom they influence, the

1	challenge and adventure of receiving Jesus Christ as Savior and
2	Lord, serving Him in their relationships, and in the fellowship of
3	the church"; and
4	WHEREAS, a key to the strong beginning of FCA was the
5	endorsement of great men of faith in college and professional
6	sports, including University of Oklahoma Head Football Coach Bud
7	Wilkinson who, after a spring practice in 1956, introduced FCA to
8	his team through the testimony of Doak Walker, Otto Graham and
9	Pepper Martin; and
10	WHEREAS, through Coach Wilkinson's influence core members of his
11	football team like Clendon Thomas and Chuck Bowman attended the
12	first FCA Summer Camp in 1956 in Estes Park, Colorado, a camp with
13	two hundred fifty-six college athletes that focused on "Inspiration
14	and Perspiration"; and
15	WHEREAS, from its origin in Oklahoma and due to the bold vision,
16	leadership and faith of Oklahoma coaches and athletes like Don
17	McClanen, Bud Wilkinson, Clendon Thomas, Chuck Bowman and countless
18	others the Fellowship of Christian Athletes has spread throughout
19	the United States and into forty-four countries internationally.
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
21	OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 55TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:
22	THAT Thursday, April 2, 2015, is hereby proclaimed as FCA Day in
23	Oklahoma in honor of the impact Oklahoma has had on the world
24	through the Fellowship of Christian Athletes.

1	THAT Don McClanen, Bud Wilkinson, Clendon Thomas and Chuck
2	Bowman are to be commended for being instrumental in the influence
3	of the Fellowship of Christian Athletes.
4	THAT copies of this resolution be distributed to Chuck Bowman,
5	Clendon Thomas and Jay Wilkinson, son of Bud Wilkinson.
