12	WHEREAS, the United States Government has declared April as
13	Sexual Assault Awareness Month and the organization known as Peace
14	Over Violence has declared April 24, 2019, as Denim Day; and
15	WHEREAS, both events are intended to draw attention to the fact
16	that sexual violence remains a serious issue in our society; and
17	WHEREAS, harmful attitudes about all forms of sexual violence
18	allow these issues to persist and allow victims and survivors of
19	sexual violence to be revictimized; and
20	WHEREAS, sexual harassment is part of a continuum of violence
21	whose damaging effects are felt throughout our culture; and
22	WHEREAS, Sexual Assault Awareness Month and Denim Day were also
23	instituted to call attention to misconceptions and misinformation
24	about sexual violence and the problem that many people in our

society remain disturbingly uninformed with respect to issues of sexual harassment, assault, abuse and rape; and

WHEREAS, every two minutes someone in America is sexually assaulted and approximately one in four women are raped during their lifetime; and

WHEREAS, youth under eighteen (18) years of age account for about forty-four percent (44%) of all reported sexual assaults, at least twenty-five percent (25%) of women experience sexual harassment in the workplace and about seventy-five percent (75%) of sexual harassment victims experience retaliation when he or she reports it; and

WHEREAS, with proper education on the matter and comprehensive prevention projects, sexual violence and its unfair and traumatizing effects are preventable; and

WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives strongly support the efforts of Peace Over Violence and the Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) of Oklahoma City to educate persons in our state about the true impact of sexual harassment, abuse, assault and rape in Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT the Oklahoma House of Representatives does hereby proclaim the month of April as Sexual Assault Awareness Month.
