AS INTRODUCED

A Resolution recognizing February 7, 2024, as Rose Day 2024 at the State Capitol; and expressing the significance of Rose Day.

11 introduction and enactment of legislation to protect unborn  
12 children; and

13           WHEREAS, on Rose Day 2024, hundreds of our fellow Oklahomans  
14 will take time out of their busy lives to come to their State  
15 Capitol to make a public statement respecting the sanctity of human  
16 life and the worth of every unborn individual and to speak with  
17 their elected officials; and

18           WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives  
19 greatly appreciate the heartfelt involvement of these committed  
20 Oklahoma citizens, both young and old, male and female.
