18	WHEREAS, neurofibromatosis causes tumors to form along the
19	nerves anywhere in or on the body at any time and its symptoms
20	include, but are not limited to, disfigurement, learning
21	disabilities, brain tumors, blindness, deafness, epilepsy, scoliosis
22	and cancer; and
23	WHEREAS, to date, there is no cure or effective treatment for
24	NF; and

2	therapies for early intervention and other necessary and critical
3	treatments and encourage further research into this disorder.
