the prosecution and attorneys for the defendant in the criminal case of State of Oklahoma vs. Benjamin Lawrence Petty, Murray County District Court Case Number CF-2016-00159; and WHEREAS, the failure of District Judge Wallace Coppedge to reject the terms of the negotiated plea bargain constitutes a gross

WHEREAS, District Judge Wallace Coppedge, Marshall County Judge

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution provides that the judges of any court, exercising judicial power under the provisions of Article VII, or under any other provision of the Oklahoma Constitution, shall be subject to removal from office by proceedings in the Court on the Judiciary; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution provides certain causes for the removal of a judge from office, which includes gross neglect of duty; and

WHEREAS, the Court on the Judiciary, created pursuant to Section 2 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution, is vested with sole and exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine causes concerning the removal of judges from office; and
