8	A Resolution petitioning the Trial Division of the Court on the Judiciary to assume jurisdiction and
9	institute proceedings for the removal of a certain judge from office; and directing distribution.

12	WHEREAS, the Code of Judicial Conduct for Oklahoma judges
13	provides that an independent and honorable judiciary is
14	indispensable to justice in our society and that a judge should
15	participate in establishing, maintaining and enforcing high
16	standards of conduct; and
17	WHEREAS, personal observation of high standards is critical so
18	that the integrity and independence of the judiciary will be
19	preserved; and
20	WHEREAS, the Code of Judicial Conduct for Oklahoma judges
21	further provides that a judge should respect and comply with the law
22	and act at all times in a manner that promotes public confidence in
23	the integrity and impartiality of the judiciary; and

1 WHEREAS, District Judge Wallace Coppedge, Marshall County Judge 2 of the Twentieth Judicial District, exercising judicial power under the Oklahoma Constitution and laws of the State of Oklahoma, has 3 4 wholly failed to comply with certain provisions of the Code of 5 Judicial Conduct by authorizing the plea bargain negotiated between the prosecution and attorneys for the defendant in the criminal case 6 7 of State of Oklahoma vs. Benjamin Lawrence Petty, Murray County District Court Case Number CF-2016-00159; and 8

9 WHEREAS, the failure of District Judge Wallace Coppedge to 10 reject the terms of the negotiated plea bargain constitutes a gross 11 neglect of duty; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution provides that the judges of any court, exercising judicial power under the provisions of Article VII, or under any other provision of the Oklahoma Constitution, shall be subject to removal from office by proceedings in the Court on the Judiciary; and

WHEREAS, Section 1 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution provides certain causes for the removal of a judge from office, which includes gross neglect of duty; and

20 WHEREAS, the Court on the Judiciary, created pursuant to Section 21 2 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution, is vested with sole 22 and exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine causes concerning 23 the removal of judges from office; and

WHEREAS, jurisdiction of the Trial Division of the Court on the
 Judiciary may be invoked and proceedings commenced upon the filing
 of a Resolution of the House of Representatives of the State of
 Oklahoma.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE 2ND SESSION OF THE 56TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT pursuant to Section 4 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma 7 8 Constitution, the House of Representatives of the State of Oklahoma 9 petitions the Trial Division of the Court on the Judiciary to assume 10 jurisdiction and institute proceedings to remove District Judge 11 Wallace Coppedge, Marshall County Judge of the Twentieth Judicial 12 District from office for gross neglect of duty which, pursuant to 13 Section 1 of Article VII-A of the Oklahoma Constitution, shall be 14 cause for removal from such office.

15 THAT a copy of this resolution be dispatched to each member of 16 the Court on the Judiciary, the Clerk of the Oklahoma Supreme Court 17 and the Administrative Director of the Courts.
