12	WHEREAS, emergency medical services (EMS) is a vital public
13	service; and
14	WHEREAS, the members of EMS teams are ready to provide
15	lifesaving care to those in need 24 hours per day, 7 days per week;
16	and
17	WHEREAS, access to quality emergency care dramatically improves
18	the survival and recovery rate of those who experience sudden
19	illness or injury; and
20	WHEREAS, EMS has grown to fill a gap by providing important out-
21	of-hospital care, including preventative medicine, follow-up care
22	and access to telemedicine; and
23	WHEREAS, the EMS system consists of first responders, emergency
24	medical dispatchers, emergency medical technicians, paramedics,

1 firefighters, police officers, pre-hospital nurses, emergency 2 nurses, emergency physicians, educators, administrators and other 3 out-of-hospital medical care providers and trained members of the 4 public; and

5 WHEREAS, the members of the EMS system, whether volunteer or 6 career, engage in thousands of hours of specialized training and 7 continuing education to enhance their lifesaving skills; and

8 WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value, commitment 9 and accomplishments of EMS providers by designating National 10 Emergency Medical Services Week.

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
12 OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

13 THAT May 19 through May 25, 2019, be designated as "National 14 Emergency Medical Services Week" with the theme "EMS Strong: Beyond 15 the Call" recognizing the professional commitment of those 16 individuals and organizations that represent the EMS system in the 17 Great State of Oklahoma.
