A Resolution proclaiming May 19 through May 25, 2019, as National Emergency Medical Services Week.

WHEREAS, emergency medical services (EMS) is a vital public service; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate to recognize the value, commitment and accomplishments of EMS providers by designating National Emergency Medical Services Week.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE 1ST SESSION OF THE 57TH OKLAHOMA LEGISLATURE:

THAT May 19 through May 25, 2019, be designated as "National Emergency Medical Services Week" with the theme "EMS Strong: Beyond the Call" recognizing the professional commitment of those individuals and organizations that represent the EMS system in the Great State of Oklahoma.
