8	A Resolution declaring May 13, 2015, as Lupus Advocacy Day and May 2015 as Lupus Awareness Month in

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13	WHEREAS, each year May is designated as National Lupus Awareness								
14	Month to show support for the estimated two million Americans,								
15	including approximately 50,000 Oklahomans, who have Lupus; and								
16	WHEREAS, more women die each year from Lupus-related symptoms								
17	than of breast cancer; and medical research efforts into Lupus and								
18	the discovery of safer, more effective treatments for Lupus patients								
19	are underfunded in comparison with diseases of comparable magnitude								
20	and severity; and								
21	WHEREAS, Lupus is an acute and chronic autoimmune disease in								
22	which the immune system is unbalanced, causing inflammation and								
23	tissue damage to virtually every organ system in the body; and								
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WHEREAS, Lupus can affect any part of the body, including the
 skin, lungs, heart, kidneys and brain; and can cause seizures,
 strokes, heart attacks, miscarriages, organ failures and, in some
 cases, death; and

5 WHEREAS, while Lupus can strike people regardless of gender or 6 age, 90 percent of individuals diagnosed with the disease are women 7 mostly of childbearing age. African Americans, Native Americans, 8 Hispanic/Latino Americans and Asian Americans are two to three times 9 more likely to develop Lupus, a disparity that remains unexplained; 10 and

WHEREAS, Lupus can be particularly difficult to diagnose because its symptoms are similar to those of many other illnesses, and major gaps exist in understanding the causes and consequences of Lupus; and

WHEREAS, the Lupus Foundation of Oklahoma and the Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation in Oklahoma City have distinguished themselves as state and national leaders in Lupus advocacy, awareness, education, outreach, referral, support, research and treatment.
