1	WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives have
2	led the nation in adopting legislation to defend unborn children;
3	and
4	WHEREAS, embryonic stem cell research leads to the destruction
5	of embryonic human beings; and
6	WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives oppose
7	any policy that would require citizens to pay for abortions through
8	their taxpayer dollars or medical insurance premiums; and
9	WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives are
10	opposed to trafficking in body parts of aborted babies; and
11	WHEREAS, Oklahoma will continue to lead the nation in the
12	introduction and enactment of legislation to protect unborn
13	children; and
14	WHEREAS, on Rose Day 2020, hundreds of our fellow Oklahomans
15	will take time out of their busy lives to come to their State
16	Capitol to make a public statement respecting the sanctity of human
17	life and the worth of every unborn individual and to speak with
18	their elected officials; and
19	WHEREAS, members of the Oklahoma House of Representatives
20	greatly appreciate the heartfelt involvement of these committed
21	Oklahoma citizens, both young and old, male and female.
22	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
