6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to elections; creating the Oklahoma
8 Youth Election Ambassador pilot program; stating
9 purpose of program; establishing qualifications for
10 participation in program; establishing duties of
11 participants in program; prohibiting certain duties;
12 authorizing Secretary of State Election Board to
13 promulgate rules; providing for noncodification; and
14 providing an effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

16 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be
17 codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

18 There is hereby created the Oklahoma Youth Election Ambassador
19 pilot program to allow students to serve as interns for county
20 election boards during elections. To serve as a youth election
21 ambassador, a person shall be at least seventeen (17) years of age,
22 a resident of the county for which the appointment is made, and
23 shall not be a member of the immediate family of a candidate whose
24 name will appear on the ballot in the precinct to which the person
is appointed. The duties of a youth election ambassador shall be
determined by and under the supervision of county election

officials, but shall not include determining the qualifications of a voter, operation or maintenance of voting equipment or the counting of votes. The Secretary of the State Election Board may promulgate rules as necessary to effectuate the implementation of the Oklahoma Youth Election Ambassador pilot program.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
