PE I

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to elections; creating the Oklahoma Youth Election Ambassador pilot program; stating purpose of program; establishing qualifications for participation in program; establishing duties of participants in program; prohibiting certain duties; authorizing Secretary of State Election Board to promulgate rules; providing for noncodification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

There is hereby created the Oklahoma Youth Election Ambassador pilot program to allow students to serve as interns for county election boards during elections. To serve as a youth election ambassador, a person shall be at least seventeen (17) years of age, a resident of the county for which the appointment is made, and shall not be a member of the immediate family of a candidate whose name will appear on the ballot in the precinct to which the person is appointed. The duties of a youth election ambassador shall be determined by and under the supervision of county election
