AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the environment and natural resources; prohibiting Department of Environmental Quality from requiring air curtain incinerators in certain areas; directing Department to promulgate rules; defining term; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2-5-130 of Title 27A, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Department of Environmental Quality shall not require the use of an air curtain incinerator for fires purposely set for land clearing operations except in municipalities with a population of greater than nine hundred thousand (900,000) people according to the latest federal decennial census. For the purposes of this section, "air curtain incinerator" means an incineration unit, operating by forcefully projecting a curtain of air across an open integrated combustion chamber or open pit or trench, in which combustion
