17	A. If a school district board of education has adopted a policy
18	for drug testing of school employees for controlled substances that
19	are included in Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous
20	Substances Act, the policy shall include a provision requiring the
21	dismissal of an employee who tests positive on a single drug test.
22	B. The dismissal of an employee pursuant to this section shall
23	be exempt from the due process procedures provided by Section 6-
24	101 20 of sog of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutos

1	C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not
2	apply to a positive test for marijuana if the employee is a patient
3	licensed by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority.
4	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2023.
5	SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
6	of the public peace, health, or safety, an emergency is hereby
7	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
8	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
