An Act relating to the Oklahoma Open Records Act; amending 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.26, which relates to intergovernmental self-insurance pools; providing for confidentiality of certain records; and providing an effective date.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Open Records Act

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 51 O.S. 2011, Section 24A.26, is amended to read as follows:

Section 24A.26. An intergovernmental self-insurance pool may keep confidential proprietary information, such as actuarial reports, underwriting calculations, rating information, records received from risk pool participants that can otherwise be obtained from risk pool participants and records that are created based on conclusions of such information that are developed through the operation of the intergovernmental self-insurance pool.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
