7 8	An Act relating to elections; amending Section 1, Chapter 87, O.S.L. 2015 and 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4- 112, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 87, O.S.L. 2015
9	(26 O.S. Supp. 2015, Sections 4-109.4 and 4-112), which relate to voter registration applications;
10	modifying procedures for verification of application information; applying certain provisions of Open Records Act to information obtained pursuant to
11	electronic voter registration application; modifying information required to be contained on voter
12	registration application; clarifying designation of persons not indicating political affiliation;
13	providing for acceptance and use of federal forms; requiring certain signature, autograph or mark;
14	granting certain authority to Secretary of State Election Board; requiring certain information to be
15	kept confidential; and declaring an emergency.
16	
17	
18	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
19	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 87, O.S.L. 2015
20	(26 O.S. Supp. 2015, Section 4-109.4), is amended to read as
21	follows:
22	Section 4-109.4. A. A person may submit a voter registration
23	application electronically as provided in this section if such
24	person:

Has a current and valid Oklahoma driver license or
 identification card issued by the Department of Public Safety
 pursuant to the provisions of Section 6-101 et seq. of Title 47 of
 the Oklahoma Statutes;

5 2. Is registering to vote at the address shown on the driver6 license or identification card; and

7 3. Is a qualified elector and entitled to become a registered
8 voter as provided by law.

9 Β. The Secretary of the State Election Board, subject to 10 available funding, shall establish a secure website to permit persons described in subsection A of this section to submit voter 11 12 registration applications electronically. The website must permit such persons to submit an application to register to vote or to 13 update an existing registration. The Secretary may employ security 14 15 measures he or she deems necessary to ensure the accuracy and integrity of voter registration applications submitted 16 17 electronically and may establish an initial date on which voter registration applications may be submitted electronically after 18 establishment of the website. 19

C. 1. The applicant must attest to the truth of the
information provided on the application by affirmatively accepting
the information as true and correct. Any person who submits false
information on an electronic voter registration application shall be

deemed guilty of a felony as described in Sections 16-103 and 16 103.1 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes this title.

2. The applicant must affirmatively consent to the use of his 4 or her driver license or identification card <u>record and</u> signature 5 for voter registration purposes.

3. A voter registration application properly submitted
electronically shall be considered by the State Election Board in
the same manner as a registration application submitted by mail.

9 D. <u>1.</u> When an applicant submits a voter registration 10 application electronically, the Secretary shall generate an 11 electronic confirmation on the website that the application has been 12 received, with instructions as to how the applicant may check the 13 status of the application thereafter.

2. In addition, the Secretary shall obtain a digital copy 14 15 compare the information contained in the record of the applicant's 16 driver license or identification card from of the Department of Public Safety and shall compare with the information submitted on 17 the application to the information shown on the digital copy and 18 ensure that the information on the application substantially matches 19 the information in the driver license or identification card record. 20 3. If the Secretary finds that the application is in compliance 21

22 with this section and all applicable laws relating to voter
23 registration, the digital signature <u>contained in the driver license</u>
24 or identification card record of the applicant shall be obtained

1 <u>from the Department of Public Safety and</u> included on the application
2 and the application shall be processed as provided by law.

3 <u>Provided, the Secretary of the State Election Board may utilize an</u> 4 <u>alternative method of obtaining the signature of the applicant, if</u> 5 necessary.

<u>4.</u> If the Secretary does not so find, the applicant shall be
notified that the application has been rejected and the reasons for
such rejection.

9 Ε. The provisions of Section 24A.5 of Title 51 of the Oklahoma Statutes relating to confidentiality of personal information within 10 11 driver records as defined by the Driver's Privacy Protection Act, 18 12 United States Code, Sections 2721 through 2725, shall be applicable to information obtained by the State Election Board from voter 13 registration applications or digital copies of driver licenses or 14 15 identification cards pursuant to the provisions of this section. F. The Secretary shall have the authority to promulgate rules 16 as may be necessary to implement the provisions of this section. 17 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2011, Section 4-112, as 18 amended by Section 6, Chapter 87, O.S.L. 2015 (26 O.S. Supp. 2015, 19 Section 4-112), is amended to read as follows: 20

Section 4-112. A. The Secretary of the State Election Board shall devise and distribute a registration application form to be used for registering voters. Such registration application shall contain the following information:

The applicant's full name and date of birth, county and
 place of residence, and mailing address pursuant to the provisions
 of subsection G of this section;

4 2. The names of political parties <u>A space or section to</u>
5 <u>designate a political party</u> recognized by the laws of the State of
6 Oklahoma with which the applicant may chooses to be affiliated;

7 3. The Oklahoma driver license or identification card number if 8 the applicant has been issued a current and valid driver license or 9 identification card by the Department of Public Safety, or if the 10 applicant does not have a valid Oklahoma driver license or 11 identification card, the last four digits of the voter's social 12 security number;

4. An oath of the eligibility of the applicant to become a
 registered voter; and

5. Such other information as may be deemed necessary by the
Secretary to identify such applicant and to ascertain his or her
eligibility.

B. A voter registration application shall be signed by the applicant in writing. The applicant shall personally subscribe his or her name to or make his or her mark on the application, and no agent, representative or employee of the applicant may sign or mark on the applicant's behalf. The signature or mark must be the original, handwritten signature, autograph or mark of the applicant. No facsimile, reproduction, typewritten or other substitute

1 signature, autograph or mark will be valid. Notwithstanding any law 2 to the contrary, the Secretary of the State Election Board shall 3 prescribe procedures to authorize any person incapable of personally making a mark to complete a voter registration application with 4 5 assistance of an official of any voter registration agency or motor license agency specified in Sections 4-109.2 and 4-109.3 of this 6 7 title. Provided, for applications submitted electronically, in lieu of the signature requirements set forth in this subsection, the 8 9 applicant shall affirmatively consent to the use of his or her 10 driver license or identification card signature as provided in Section 1 of this act. 11

C. Persons who do not indicate a recognized political party or political organization on their registration application shall be designated as Independents Independent (no party).

D. Any person may apply in writing to the Secretary of the State Election Board for permission to print, copy or otherwise prepare and distribute the registration applications designed by the Secretary of the State Election Board. The Secretary may revoke any such permission at any time.

E. All registration applications shall be distributed to thepublic at no charge.

F. The Secretary also shall prescribe procedures to accept and
use federal registration applications the National Mail Voter
<u>Registration Form, or its successor</u>, as required by the National

Voter Registration Act of 1993. <u>Provided, the form shall include an</u>
 <u>original, handwritten signature, autograph or mark as described in</u>
 subsection B of this section.

G. Applicants for voter registration or for change of voter 4 5 registration in any way shall provide a residence address and, if different from the residence address, a mailing address. A 6 residence address shall include the street address of the residence, 7 including a full house number, street name or number, apartment or 8 9 suite number, if applicable, and zip code. If a street address is 10 not available for the residence, applicants shall provide such information as the Secretary of the State Election Board deems 11 12 necessary for voter registration purposes. A post office box may not be given as a residence address. A mailing address, which shall 13 include the city and zip code, may be the actual emergency 14 notification or 911 address on file in the local community, a rural 15 route and box number, a post office box number or a street address. 16 H. A full or partial Social Security number or driver license 17 number in a voter registration record or a voter registration 18 application shall be kept confidential by the State Election Board 19 and each county election board, except by order of a court of record 20 21 in this state.

22 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
