Any pawnbroker shall make available a copy or 14 report within three (3) two (2) days of any buy or pawn transaction 15 to the local law enforcement agency of the municipality or other 16 political subdivision in which the pawnshop is located; provided, 17 merchandise bought on invoice from a manufacturer or wholesaler with 18 an established place of business is exempt from this reporting 19 requirement. However, such invoice shall be shown upon request to 20 the Administrator or his duly authorized representative or any 21 authorized peace officer. The pawnbroker may provide the 22 23 transaction report to the local law enforcement agency by either 24 electronically reporting the information in the transaction report
