6 AS INTRODUCED

7 An Act relating to motor vehicles; requiring
8 Department of Public Safety promulgate rules and
9 regulations for a vehicle emissions inspection
10 program; requiring emissions inspection biennially;
11 requiring possession of inspection record; requiring
12 certain vehicles are included; requiring passing of
13 inspection to renew registration; requiring hybrid
14 vehicles obtain certain inspection; exempting
15 electric vehicles; requiring proof of emissions
16 inspection when selling a vehicle; detailing
17 applicability of act; requiring implementation by
18 certain date; providing for codification; and
19 providing an effective date.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

21 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 862 of Title 47, unless there is
23 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

24 The Department of Public Safety shall promulgate rules and
25 regulations necessary to implement a vehicle emissions inspection
26 program that complies with established best practices including, but
27 not limited to, regulations as posted in the Federal Register.

28 1. The program shall require that:

- 1 a. a vehicle passes an emissions inspection every two (2)
2 years prior to renewing registration,
3
4 b. a certificate or other documentation showing the
5 vehicle identification number, date of last emissions
6 inspection and whether the vehicle is in compliance
7 with the provisions of this section and of the rules
8 and regulations promulgated as prescribed in this
9 section is provided to the vehicle owner at the time
10 an inspection is completed,
11
12 c. a vehicle owner maintains in the vehicle at all times
13 an emissions inspection certificate demonstrating the
14 vehicle is in compliance with the testing requirements
15 promulgated according to the provisions of this
16 section,
17
18 d. all vehicles that require annual vehicle registration
19 renewal participate including, but not limited to,
20 passenger vehicles and light trucks,
21
22 e. drivers present certification of the vehicle passing
23 emissions inspection as a prerequisite to renewing
24 registration,
25
26 f. hybrid vehicles obtain an Onboard Diagnostic (OBD)
27 emission inspection,
28
29 g. electric vehicles are exempt from emissions inspection
30 requirement, and

1 h. any person or entity selling a vehicle shall provide
2 the most recent emissions inspection report at the
3 time of sale;

4 2. The provisions of this section shall apply to vehicles older
5 than two (2) but not older than thirty (30) years old;

6 3. The provisions of this section shall be implemented by
7 January 1, 2024.

8 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2021.
