- B. All health benefit plans shall include the coverage 4 5 specified by this section for a low-dose mammography screening for the presence of occult breast cancer. Such If a female's previous 6 low-dose mammography screening demonstrated dense breast tissue, as 7 defined in this subsection, the plan shall cover a four-dimensional 8 9 breast magnetic resonance imaging (MRI) in lieu of a low-dose 10 mammography screening. As used in this paragraph, "dense breast 11 tissue" means heterogeneously dense tissue or extremely dense tissue 12 as defined in the Breast Imaging and Reporting Data System established by the American College of Radiology. 13
- 14 <u>C. The</u> coverage <u>required pursuant to subsection B of this</u>
 15 section shall not:
 - 1. Be subject to the policy deductible, co-payments and co-insurance limits of the plan; $\frac{\partial}{\partial x}$
 - 2. Require that a female undergo a mammography screening at a specified time as a condition of payment; or
 - 3. Be subject to pre-authorization from the insurer.
