16	SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the University	
17	Hospitals Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st	
18	Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Five Million Dollars	
19	(\$5,000,000.00) shall be used for support of the Oklahoma Health	
20	Care Authority's Diagnostic Related Grouping (DRG) maintenance of	
21	effort, Six Hundred Twenty-nine Thousand Forty Dollars (\$629,040.00)
22	shall be used for support of the Oklahoma Health Care Authority's	
23	medical flight transportation maintenance of effort, One Million	
24	Five Hundred Eighty-six Thousand Two Hundred Fourteen Dollars	

(\$1,586,214.00) shall be used to support the Oklahoma Health Care
 Authority's Level I Trauma maintenance of effort and Two Million One
 Hundred Twenty-six Thousand Four Hundred Fifteen Dollars
 (\$2,126,415.00) shall be used to support the Oklahoma Health Care
 Authority's Hospital Graduate Medical Education program maintenance
 of effort.

7 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the University 8 Hospitals Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st 9 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Five Million Dollars 10 (\$5,000,000.00) shall be used to modernize research facilities and 11 equipment at the OU Health Sciences Center Biomedical Sciences 12 Building.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the University 13 Hospitals Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st 14 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Forty Million Six Hundred 15 Six Thousand Seventy-eight Dollars (\$40,606,078.00) shall be used 16 for duties including the University of Oklahoma Dean's GME Program. 17 SECTION 4. OUHSC shall ensure that in addition to funding the 18 Dean's GME Program for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, funds 19 received pursuant to Section 3 of this act in combination with funds 20 received from the Dean's GME transition payments for the fiscal year 21 ending June 30, 2019, are used to: 22

Reimburse the Oklahoma Health Care Authority an amount equal
 to the proportionate share of OUHSC's Dean's GME program

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1 disallowance for each of the four quarters of the state fiscal year 2 ending June 30, 2020; and

3 2. Budget an additional Eight Million Three Hundred Thousand
4 Dollars (\$8,300,000.00) in one-time funds on research programs.

5 OUHSC shall calculate the net collection from the Dean's GME 6 transition payments for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, less 7 the provisions of paragraphs 1 and 2 of this section. OUHSC shall 8 ensure the remaining balance from this calculation shall be budgeted 9 equally between an electronic health record conversion and support 10 of one-time research initiatives.

11 SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the University 12 Hospitals Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st 13 Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Two Million Five Hundred 14 Ninety-five Thousand Eight Hundred Sixty-seven Dollars 15 (\$2,595,867.00) shall be used for providing audiologist- and speech 16 pathologist-related services for children.

SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the University Hospitals Authority in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, Five Hundred Ten Thousand Dollars (\$510,000.00) shall be used to support the Oklahoma Center for Poison and Drug Information.

22 SECTION 7. The CEO of the University Hospitals Authority may 23 request through the Director of the Office of Management and 24 Enterprise Services the early transfer by the Oklahoma Tax

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Commission of tax collections to the General Revenue Fund for the
 purpose of early allocation to the Authority's disbursing funds to
 alleviate cash-flow problems.

SECTION 8. Appropriations made by Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 4 5 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not including appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 6 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 (hereafter FY-20), or may be 7 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2021 (hereafter FY-21). 8 9 Funds budgeted for FY-20 may be encumbered only through June 30, 10 2020, and must be expended by November 15, 2020. Any funds 11 remaining after November 15, 2020, and not budgeted for FY-21, shall lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal 12 year. Funds budgeted for FY-21 may be encumbered only through June 13 Any funds remaining after November 15, 2021, shall lapse 14 30, 2021. 15 to the credit of the proper fund for the then-current fiscal year. These appropriations shall not be budgeted in both fiscal years 16 17 simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-20, and not required to pay obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-21, after 18 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 19 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds 20 from the FY-20 budget work program and after such revision has been 21 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 22 SECTION 9. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019. 23
