15	Section 1685. <u>A.</u> Any person who shall willfully or maliciously				
16	torture, destroy or kill, or cruelly beat or injure, maim or				
17	mutilate any animal in subjugation or captivity, whether wild or				
18	tame, and whether belonging to the person or to another, or deprive				
19	any such animal of necessary food, drink, shelter, or veterinary				
20	care to prevent suffering; or who shall cause, procure or permit any				
21	such animal to be so tortured, destroyed or killed, or cruelly				
22	beaten or injured, maimed or mutilated, or deprived of necessary				
23	food, drink, shelter, or veterinary care to prevent suffering; or				
24	who shall willfully set on foot, instigate, engage in, or in any way

1	further any act of cruelty to any animal, or any act tending to				
2	produce such cruelty, shall be guilty of a felony <u>misdemeanor for</u>				
3	the first offense and shall be punished by imprisonment in the State				
4	Penitentiary not exceeding five (5) years, or by imprisonment in the				
5	county jail not exceeding one (1) year, or by a fine not exceeding				
6	Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00) punishable by the imposition of a				
7	fine not exceeding One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or by				
8	imprisonment in the county jail not exceeding one (1) year or both				
9	such fine and imprisonment. Any animal so maltreated or abused

11	B. A person who commits a second or subsequent offense of

14	Department of Corrections for a period of not more than five (5)				
15	years, or by a fine not to exceed Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).				
16	C. Any animal so maltreated or abused shall be considered an				
17	abused or neglected animal.				
18	D. Any person convicted of an offense under this section shall				
19	be required to pay any fees incurred as a result of impoundment of				
20	the animal maltreated, as well as board and care fees, including				
21	charges for veterinary services while any animal is impounded, prior				
22	to the release of any such animal.
