There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma State 15 Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control from any monies not 16 17 otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023, the sum of Five 18 Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,300,000.00) or so much 19 thereof as may be necessary to enhance the operation of the 20 Marijuana Enforcement Teams. 21 SECTION 2. Appropriations made by this act, not including 22 appropriations made for capital outlay purposes, may be budgeted for 23 the fiscal year ending June 30, 2023 (hereafter FY-23), or may be 24

1 budgeted for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2024 (hereafter FY-24). Funds budgeted for FY-23 may be encumbered only through June 30, 2 2023, and must be expended by November 15, 2023. Any funds 3 remaining after November 15, 2023, and not budgeted for FY-24, shall 4 5 lapse to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. Funds budgeted for FY-24 may be encumbered only through June 6 30, 2024. Any funds remaining after November 15, 2024, shall lapse 7 to the credit of the proper fund for the then current fiscal year. 9 These appropriations may not be budgeted in both fiscal years simultaneously. Funds budgeted in FY-23, and not required to pay 10 obligations for that fiscal year, may be budgeted for FY-24, after 11 12 the agency to which the funds have been appropriated has prepared 13 and submitted a budget work program revision removing these funds from the FY-23 budget work program and after such revision has been 14 approved by the Office of Management and Enterprise Services. 15 16 17 DIRECT TO CALENDAR. 18

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
