17	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
18	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 229 of Title 56, unless there is
19	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
20	There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund
21	for the Department of Human Services to be designated the "OK
22	Benefits Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
23	subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all monies
24	designated to the fund by law. The Director of the Department of

1 Human Services shall, at the end of each month, provide a current balance and statement of encumbrances of the fund to the Chair of 2 3 the Senate Appropriations Committee and the Chair of the House of Representatives Committee on Appropriations and Budget. All monies 4 5 accruing to the credit of the fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the Department of Human Services for the 6 7 sole purpose of the acquisition, operation, maintenance, repair and replacement of the OK Benefits system at the Department of Human 8 9 Services. Expenditures from the fund shall be made upon warrants 10 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by 11 law with the Director of the Office of Management and Enterprise 12 Services for approval and payment.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
