These funds shall not supplant the current Pay for Success program funding and the agency 6 7 shall budget no less than the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the amount listed above for 8 9 this purpose.

10 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of 11 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 12 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of 13 Sixteen Million Four Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$16,417,000.00) shall be used to fund the Information Services 14 15 Division. These funds shall not supplant the current Information Services Division funding and the agency shall budget no less than 16 the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 17 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose. 18

19 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

20 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation 21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby 22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and 23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
