7 An Act relating to the Office of Management and
8 Enterprise Services; requiring that portions of
9 certain appropriated funds be used for certain
10 purposes; prohibiting supplantation of funding;
11 requiring a certain amount of funding be budgeted for
12 a stated purpose; providing an effective date; and
13 declaring an emergency.

14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

15 SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
16 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765
17 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Six
18 Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,300,000.00) shall be used
19 to fund operations of the Capital Assets Management and Central
20 Accounting and Reporting Divisions. These funds shall not supplant
21 the current Capital Assets Management and Central Accounting and
22 Reporting Divisions funding and the agency shall budget no less than
23 the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30,
24 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

1 SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
2 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765
3 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One
4 Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used
5 to provide for the Pay For Success program. These funds shall not
6 supplant the current Pay for Success program funding and the agency
7 shall budget no less than the total of the amount budgeted in the
8 fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the amount listed above for
9 this purpose.

10 SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of
11 Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765
12 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of
13 Sixteen Million Four Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars
14 (\$16,417,000.00) shall be used to fund the Information Services
15 Division. These funds shall not supplant the current Information
16 Services Division funding and the agency shall budget no less than
17 the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30,
18 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

19 SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

20 SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
21 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
22 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
23 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.

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
