

ENROLLED SENATE BILL NO. 1061

and

Wallace and Hilbert of the House

An Act relating to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services; requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; prohibiting supplantation of funding; requiring a certain amount of funding be budgeted for a stated purpose; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Office of Management and Enterprise Services

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Six Million Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$6,300,000.00) shall be used to fund operations of the Capital Assets Management and Central Accounting and Reporting Divisions. These funds shall not supplant the current Capital Assets Management and Central Accounting and Reporting Divisions funding and the agency shall budget no less than the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of One Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$1,500,000.00) shall be used to provide for the Pay For Success program. These funds shall not supplant the current Pay for Success program funding and the agency shall budget no less than the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Office of Management and Enterprise Services in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Sixteen Million Four Hundred Seventeen Thousand Dollars (\$16,417,000.00) shall be used to fund the Information Services Division. These funds shall not supplant the current Information Services Division funding and the agency shall budget no less than the total of the amount budgeted in the fiscal year ending June 30, 2019, plus the amount listed above for this purpose.

SECTION 4. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval. Passed the Senate the 20th day of May, 2019.
