An Act relating to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry; requiring that portions of certain appropriated funds be used for certain purposes; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$200,000.00) shall be used to provide for wildfire suppression activities. These funds shall be used to provide additional wildfire suppression activities and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 2. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, the sum of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be transferred to the Healthy Food Financing Revolving Fund created by Section 5-204 of Title 2 of the Oklahoma Statutes.

SECTION 3. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to provide for feral swine control. These funds shall be used to provide additional feral swine control activities and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 4. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Ninety Thousand Dollars (\$90,000.00) shall be used to provide for veterinarian staff positions. These funds shall be used to provide additional veterinarian staff positions and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 5. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) shall be used to provide for laboratory equipment. These funds shall be used to provide additional laboratory equipment or upgrades to existing equipment and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 6. From the funds appropriated to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry in Enrolled House Bill No. 2765 of the 1st Session of the 57th Oklahoma Legislature, not less than Six Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$600,000.00) shall be used to provide for rural fire operational assistance grants. These funds shall be used to provide additional rural fire operational assistance grants and shall be used to supplement rather than replace existing resources.

SECTION 7. This act shall become effective July 1, 2019.

SECTION 8. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
