SENATE BILL 1065

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to food establishments; defining term; prohibiting certain conduct; providing for enforcement; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-1119.1 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. As used in this section, "consumer" means a person who is a member of the public, takes possession of food or drink, is not functioning in the capacity of an operator of a food establishment and does not offer the food or drink for resale.

B. A food establishment licensed under Section 1-1118 of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes that provides a consumer with a straw shall not provide a straw made of nonplastic materials including, but not limited to, paper or pasta.

1 C. This section shall be enforced by the State Department of
2 Health. Any violations of subsection B of this section shall result
3 in a notice of violation.

4 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
5 of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
6 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
7 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
