11	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2011, Section 1000.2, as
12	amended by Section 2, Chapter 332, O.S.L. 2013 (59 O.S. Supp. 2015,
13	Section 1000.2), is amended to read as follows:
14	Section 1000.2. A. The Construction Industries Board is hereby
15	created to continue until July 1, 2016, in accordance with the
16	provisions of the Oklahoma Sunset Law. The Board shall regulate the
17	plumbing, electrical and mechanical trades, the building and
18	construction inspectors, and the roofing contractors through the
19	powers and duties set forth in the Construction Industries Board Act
20	and in the respective licensing or registration acts for such
21	trades, or as otherwise provided by law.
22	B. 1. Beginning July 1, 2013 July 1, 2016, the Board shall be
23	composed of seven (7) members appointed by the Governor with the
24	advice and consent of the Senate, as follows:

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- 1a.two members one membershall have at least ten (10)2years' experience in the plumbing trade, of which one3shall be a plumbing contractor and one shall be a4journeyman plumber,
- b. two members shall have at least ten (10) years'
 experience in the electrical trade, of which one shall
 be an electrical contractor and one shall be a
 journeyman electrician,
- 9 c. two members <u>one member</u> shall have at least ten (10) 10 years' experience in the mechanical trade, of which 11 one shall be a mechanical contractor and one shall be 12 a mechanical journeyman, and
- 13
 d. one member shall have at least ten (10) years'

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 experience as a building and construction inspector,

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 and
- 16 <u>e.</u> two members shall be residents of this state appointed
 17 as members at-large.

2. Members shall be appointed for staggered terms of four (4) years, as designated by the Governor. Members shall continue in office until a successor is appointed by the Governor. The Governor shall fill all vacancies and unexpired terms in the same manner as the original appointment of the member whose position is to be filled. A member may be removed by the Governor at any time.

24 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2016.
