11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 323 of Title 3, unless there is
14	created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. As used in this section, "unmanned aircraft systems (UAS)"
16	means any unmanned or uninhabited vehicle that is capable of either
17	powered locomotion on the ground or powered flight in the air, or
18	both, and that does not carry a human operator on or in the vehicle.
19	A UAS may be remotely controlled or programmed to operate
20	autonomously or on planned routes.
21	B. Pipeline companies and utility companies may use UAS to
22	inspect pipelines and utility rights-of-way within the limits of
23	their authorized rights-of-way and may operate at an altitude that

provides thorough inspection of the pipelines and utility row.

1	Below two hundred (200) feet above ground level pipeline operators
2	and utility companies may operate a UAS beyond visual line of sight
3	provided:
4	1. The operator stays within the limits of the rights-of-way or
5	within the property boundaries;
6	2. The operator is able to effectively and safely maintain
7	positive control of the UAS; and
8	3. The operator yields to and remains clear of any manned
9	aircraft in the area.
10	SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
