11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
12	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
13	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-115 of Title 11, unless there
14	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
15	A. The State Legislature hereby occupies and preempts any
16	ordinance and regulation by any municipality, city, or town of this
17	state to infringe upon the rights of a United States citizen of the
18	State of Oklahoma from flying the flag of the United States on their
19	personal property.
20	B. This section shall not prohibit any municipality, city, or
21	town from enacting ordinances or regulations to limit the flag of
22	the United States by the size, number of flags, or proximity of
23	flags to roadways to comply with ordinances for public safety.

1	SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
2	of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby
3	declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
4	be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
