AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 233, O.S.L. 15 2022 (26 O.S. Supp. 2022, Section 4-120.11), is amended to read as 16 follows: 17 Section 4-120.11. A. No later than June 1 of each year, the 18 State Election Board shall perform a query of the entire voter 19 registration database to determine how many individuals are 20 registered at the same residential address. 21 If more than ten eight registered voters share a single 22 residential address, the State Election Board shall provide a list 23 of said voters to the secretary of the county election board, who

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shall immediately notify the district attorney for that county.

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C. Upon receipt of such notification, the district attorney, or a member of law enforcement designated by the district attorney, shall investigate any possible criminal violation of the law related to the voter registration.

D. Provided, this section shall not apply to registered voters sharing a residential address at a facility licensed or certified by this state, if required by law, such as an assisted living facility,

sharing a residential address at a facility licensed or certified by this state, if required by law, such as an assisted living facility, residential care facility, nursing home, veterans center, medical facility, multiunit housing, installations of the Armed Forces of the United States where uniformed or overseas voters, as defined by the Uniformed and Overseas Citizens Absentee Voting Act, are stationed, or other locations authorized in writing by the Secretary of the State Election Board.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2023.

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
