AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public buildings and public works; exempting state agencies from obtaining certain services for certain types of construction; providing exceptions; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 103.8 of Title 61, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon the effective date of this act, any state agency that is erecting a building that has a pre-fabrication design, pursuant to the provisions of the Public Competitive Bidding Act of 1974, and, in the manufacturing of that building, has already undergone engineering design and building standards, shall not be required to contract with a consultant for any engineering or architectural services. This section shall not apply to those buildings in the process of construction prior to the effective date of this act. The provisions of this section shall not apply to public schools.
