22	A. At the general election to be held in November 2020, there
23	shall be elected in each county a county school board of education.

1 Each county school board shall consist of seven (7) members to be 2 elected as follows:

1. One member elected from the first county commissioner district to serve a term of four (4) years;

- 2. One member elected from the first county commissioner district to serve an initial term of two (2) years. A member thereafter elected shall serve a term of four (4) years;
- 3. One member elected from the second county commissioner district to serve a term of four (4) years;
- 4. One member elected from the second county commissioner district to serve an initial term of two (2) years. A member thereafter elected shall serve a term of four (4) years;
- 5. One member elected from the third county commissioner district to serve a term of four (4) years;
- 6. One member elected from the third county commissioner district to serve an initial term of two (2) years. A member thereafter elected shall serve a term of four (4) years; and
- 7. One member elected to represent the county at large, who shall serve as chairman of the county school board, to serve a term of four (4) years.
- B. If during the term of office to which a person was elected, that member ceases to be a resident of the county commissioner district from which the person was elected, the office shall become

1 vacant and such vacancy shall be filled as provided in Section 13A-110 of Title 26 of the Oklahoma Statutes. 3 C. County school board elections shall be on a nonpartisan basis. 5 D. Following the general election to be held in November 2020, 6 county school board elections shall be held in November of even-7 numbered years. E. A county school board candidate receiving the highest number 9 of votes in an election shall be deemed the successful candidate. SECTION 2. The provisions of this act shall not become 10 effective as law unless Enrolled Senate Bill No. 906 of the 2nd 11 Session of the 55th Oklahoma Legislature becomes effective as law. 12 13 SECTION 3.
