16	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 25 O.S. 2011, Section 90.12, is
17	amended to read as follows:
18	Section 90.12. The <del>Third</del> <u>second</u> Monday in <del>November</del> <u>October</u> of
19	each year is designated as "Oklahoma Native American Day" in
20	Oklahoma. All citizens of this state are requested to devote some
21	portion of Oklahoma Native American Day to commemorate the
22	accomplishments of Oklahoma's Native Americans. Teachers and
23	students of the schools of this state are requested to observe the
24	day with appropriate activities.
