12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2011, Section 8-103.2, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	Section 8-103.2. A. Except as otherwise provided, a student
16	who enrolls, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act or pursuant
17	to <del>Section 2 of this act</del> <u>Section 8-113 of this title</u> , in a school
18	district in which the student is not a resident shall not be
19	eligible to participate in school-related extramural athletic
20	competition governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities
21	Association for a period of one (1) year from the first day of
22	attendance at the receiving school unless the transfer is from a
23	school district which does not offer the grade the student is
24	entitled to pursue.

- B. If the student is granted an emergency transfer pursuant to Section 8-104 of this title, was granted a transfer for any reason prior to January 1, 2000, or enrolls pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act and qualifies for a hardship waiver pursuant to the rules of the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association, eligibility to participate in school-related extramural athletic competition shall be determined by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association.
  - C. The provisions of subsection A of this section shall not apply to a student who:
- 11 <u>1. Was enrolled in a charter school established pursuant to</u>
  12 Section 3-132 of this title;
  - 2. Was participating in the charter school's extramural athletic competitions; and
  - 3. Transfers to a public school district after the charter school in which the student was enrolled ceases to operate for any reason.
- SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2020.
- SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
