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12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:
13	SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
14	in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-725 of Title 63, unless there
15	is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:
16	A. It is the duty of any person conducting or operating a
17	hospital, or any physician or nurse as soon as treatment permits, to
18	notify the local law enforcement agency of that jurisdiction upon
19	the application for treatment of a person who is not accompanied by
20	a law enforcement officer, when it reasonably appears that the
21	person requesting treatment has received:
22	1. Any injury resulting from the discharge of a firearm; or
23	2. Any injury sustained in the commission of or as a victim of

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a criminal offense.

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B. Any hospital, physician or nurse shall forever be held
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    harmless from any civil liability for their reasonable compliance
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    with the provisions of this section.
        SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2018.
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
